-Begin the YouTube video **through headphones** on a device such as your laptop, tablet, etc.

-On your phone or other audio/visual recording device, record yourself singing to the camera while listening to the YouTube video **through your headphones on your first device.**

- ***IMPORTANT: please do not sing with the YouTube video playing out loud**, or so loudly through headphones that you can hear it in your recording. There is no way to remove this from the audio if you do.

Presentation

-Please be mindful of your surroundings, as this recording will likely be shared far and wide. This includes anything (auditory or visual) that might be captured in the video such as posters on the wall, items on your shelf, barking dogs in the other room, etc.

-Make sure lighting is favorable! For instance, instead of singing with a bright window behind you, sing so that the light is shining on your face. This will make sure you are clear and visible for our audience.

-Please wear black clothing.

-Remember to smile 😊 Most importantly, have fun!
